Election of Officials

The Chair ask If any of the members would like to stand for any of the positions ... there was no proposals , the Chair then stated that the present club officials were prepared to continue in their rolls and thus was put to the vote and was PASSED

- Secretary: David Boyles was proposed by the committee and carried by the attendees.
- Treasurer: Ross McDonald was proposed by the committee and carried by the attendees.
- Chairman: Barkley Abernathy was proposed by the committee and carried by the attendees.

Club Proposals

1. **From Committee Member** - The club membership to be posted on line for insurances. this is to be done via the work rota , any person who uses the the pit lane Is now required to be a member weather it be as a full member or Non Racer member – From Committee – **This was PASSED by all @2022 AGM**
3. **From Committee Member** - Membership fees to rise from £40 to £60 , with a discount back to £40 if paid by 31st January --- (£40) , Family memberships to raise from £60 to ??? – From Committee – **Memberships payments will no longer be a Google form, will now be done on the booking in page, There will now be an existing members payment and a new members payment that way once the end of January comes we can go in and switch the payments to the higher fee for those that haven't paid on time – this was proposed and passed by all**
4. **From Committee Member** - 2023 season - All Crawler Only Members must have BRCA membership and club membership , track will open during 1/8th race days , no competitions for 2023 – From Committee – **Proposed and Passed by all**
5. **From Committee Member** - Clarification on club memberships - from 2020 season our insurance policy premiums are determined by the number of paid up club members weather they are racer / non racer / crawler... they also need to be published ... there for a small charge for non racers that has to be applied and will now continue . – From Committee **Proposed and passed by all**
6. **From Committee Member** -Propose that from the start of 2023 season that club Rounds go to 10 rounds per season and 7 from 10 to count - | – **Proposed and Passed by all**
7. **From Committee Member** -Entry fee goes to £20 , juniors will stay at £10. – **Proposed and passed by all**
8. **From Committee member** - None members can attend 3 open / practice evenings , but not races days this will also include any GP event ...
9. **From Conor Daly** – Early start time allows more time between practise and heats this will benefit the man that has to work on his own car. **It was agreed that we will triple this at the start of the 2023 season and talk about it at drivers breifing**
10. **From Conor Daly** – Electrics to have their own final if there is a separate championship than separate final. **The members decided to drop the 8 car rule to 6 cars for truck and electric to have their own final and will be reviewed at the following race day. This is not set in stone**
11. **From Daniel Miller** – Club committee members of other RCCAOI clubs are able to join BADMCC but not be required to attend work rotas, committee members do a lot of work in their respective clubs and are not able to commit to further time for work on other clubs also they are not likely to be in a position to attend

many races due to their own club commitments these committee members should also not be expected to volunteer for each other clubs work parties but are of course welcome. – **This proposal was scrapped and agreed by all**

12. **From Daniel Miller** – we reinstate the three race rule to allow non members to race at ca dmcc on the proviso that they can prove that their paid up member of another BRCA RCCAOI club thus showing their support in the scene but wish to take part in other clubs without commitment, to ensure it is fair on the club and the members and to acknowledge that these non members will not be on work rotor I suggest race fees are increased to £25 for non members and non members will not score points or have them back dated should they then join later. **It was agreed that members of other clubs are able to attend 3 club rounds as long as they also have BRCA licence , they will not score any point and the entry fee will be £30**
